### Lake Improvement Committee Meeting Minutes August 3, 2023

#### 1. Lake-wide EIR Project List:

- a. Reviewed specific, anticipated projects that have been discussed as possible areas where dredging would be beneficial.
- b. The majority of these projects would be paid for by private parties, some by the district.
- c. Projects seen on this map are because they have at one time had interests from one group or another.
- d. The projects are:
  - i. Grout Creek
    1. District would be constructing a catchment basin construction at the base of the culverts.
    2. Private would be the dredge further down the creek.
    3. Going to cut down the dredge area to make it more reasonable cost wise.
  - ii. Observatory east/west sides, which was an army corp idea many years ago, committee doesn't see a reason for it, remove project from list.
  - iii. Big Bear Shores wants to do one by their docks, but perhaps cut the center out of the dredge and make it Lighthouse and Big Bear Shores.
  - iv. East Ramp navigational dredge takes it to -26 going out of the east ramp.
    1. Considering moving the dirt to center lake instead of removing dirt and having to de-water, "trans-location" of material.
  - v. West Ramp – great value, but probably will not happen. Dredge and use dirt to double the size of the ramp parking lot.
  - vi. Eagle Point dredge should be smaller, would cut this area in half.
    1. Director Brewster suggests splitting the area in half and dredge on either side for the point.
  - vii. Mallard Lagoon – assessment district that was put together to allow this project to happen many years ago.
    1. District took logistic roles to get it done, and the residents paid the District back.
    2. There was a hump left after the dredge.
  - viii. Back of Metcalf Bay which is where Pleasure Point and Holloways are.



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1. Holloways has discussed, but Pleasure Point has not; still want to include it so they both have an opportunity if they choose.
  2. Expand to the east side of the dredge in this area, instead of taking it deeper.
  3. Boulder Bay Park – either side of the island, maybe ask the City if they are interested in this project.
    - a. But would help with the flow of water during lower lake levels.
  4. Swim Beach- Director Brewster thinks this is a huge benefit to the community.
    - i. Super important and wants to make that a priority project to get this back open again.
